The Old-Fashioned

The **Old-Fashioned** cocktail is one of the oldest and most iconic mixed drinks in the world. By the late 19th century, bartenders began experimenting with new ingredients (liqueurs, absinthe, whisky, bourbon or rye whisky etc). Patrons who preferred the simple, earlier style began asking for a drink made the "**old-fashioned way**."

Hence, the **Old-Fashioned** was born as a deliberate throwback to the original cocktail recipe.

Fun Fact:

Louisville, **KY**, has officially declared itself the "**Birthplace of the Old-Fashioned**", and celebrates **Old-Fashioned Fortnight** every June.

The Whisky Sour

A Whisky Sour is a tangy and refreshing cocktail.

The Whisky Sour's flavour profile is a perfect balance of sour, sweet, and strong. The whisky provides a rich, complex base, while the lemon juice adds a bright, citrusy note, and the simple syrup adds a touch of sweetness.

Fun Fact:

The Whisky Sour dates back to 1862 but the basic concept likely started on ships, where sailors mixed spirits with citrus (like lemon or lime) to help prevent scurvy. So in a way, the Whisky Sour might have saved lives and made them more enjoyable.

The Rusty Nail

The Rusty Nail's flavour profile is a beautiful balance of smoky, sweet, and herbal notes.

The smokiness of the Scotch pairs perfectly with the sweetness and herbal Flavors of the Drambuie.

Fun Fact: -

The Rusty Nail was once the go-to drink of the Rat Pack, especially Frank Sinatra. This smooth, smoky mix of Scotch whisky and Drambuie was seen as sophisticated yet rebellious, just like the Rat Pack themselves.
